Eastern Victoria GP Training are successful in Tender for Provision of GP Training in Eastern Victoria

Eastern Victoria GP Training (EVGPT) are pleased to announce success in their bid to deliver GP Training for Eastern Victoria.

In April this year the Minister for Health, the Honourable Sussan Ley, announced new training regions and governance arrangements for the future delivery of GP specialist training.

In 2016 up to 122 Commonwealth funded GP Registrars will commence their training in Eastern Victoria, adding to the existing GP registrars already training in the region. We expect there will be in excess of 340 GP registrars in training from the beginning of the 2016 training year.

The foundation members of EVGPT are VMA and Southern GP Training (SGPT). Importantly, we expect EVGPT will be staffed by many of those currently working with VMA and SGPT (Gippsland). We are committed to working together and with our stakeholders, to deliver a program that:
