

EVGPT Information for Applicants

1. If offered a training position, you will need to submit the following documents with your acceptance:

- **Hospital letter/s of service** - listing all rotations completed in Australia and/or New Zealand including start and end dates, number of weeks and any leave taken in the period. These will be used to assess your previous hospital experience to meeting the mandatory hospital requirements of training. They are also used to provide evidence of “practice readiness” and eligibility for Recognition of Prior Learning.



- **CV** – a copy of your updated CV
- **Confirmation of Paediatrics** – refer to RACGP’s [Mandatory Hospital Term Requirements Guidance Document](#)
- **Medical registration** - copies of initial general registration and the AMC Part 2 certificate, if relevant

2. Information Sessions

Please note that you may be required to attend various information sessions. More information will be provided in the coming months.

3. Basic Life Support

Registrars must have completed a BLS course within 12 months on commencing their first general practice term (GPT1).

4. Rural Pathway – invitation to undertake Extended and Advanced Skills Training
